In order to better understand the unique issues faced by adults with disabilities and their siblings, the Easter Seals Sibling Disability Study survey sponsored by Massachusetts Mutual Life Insurance Company (Mass Mutual), was conducted by Ipsos Public Affairs. As one of the leading consumer research companies in the U.S., the survey reveals that many adults who have a sibling with special needs already are, or at some point will be, their siblings primary caregivers.
